Matthias Bruski, a 2014 graduate from the SABIS® Network school in Frankfurt, Germany, ISF Internationale Schule Frankfurt-Rhein-Main (ISF), has just received recognition for outstanding performance on the 2014 AP® German Language and Culture exam. Not only did Matthias receive a perfect score of 5, he was also one of only 41 students in the world to earn every single possible point on the examination.

The College Board's Advanced Placement Program® (AP®) provides students with the opportunity to take rigorous college-level courses while still in high school and to earn college credit, advanced college placement, or both for successful performance on AP® exams. ISF offers a number of AP® courses including the AP® German Language and Culture exam, which engages students in an exploration of German language and culture in both contemporary and historical contexts.
